



2020 Fact Sheet

Purpose: To provide a crossover program that builds on the dance training received in the Pre-Pro workshop (and/or your studio's dance programs) and prepares dancers for the potential move into the Go Pro workshop in the future. Also, to continue to advance students in the areas of technical dance skills and performance ability. And finally, to build confidence and introduce the dance profession as a possible career option for dance students who are seriously ready to train hard for it.

Date: Sunday, July 26 to Wednesday, July 29

Location: Branson, Missouri (Radisson Hotel)

Full Program Fee: \$1095.00 total prior to any discounts being applied (\$895 AFTER SCHOLARSHIP).

Discount: \$200.00 Scholarship awarded to selected dancers (limit one scholarship discount per dancer).

Online Application: To begin the application process log on to talentonparade.com and click on the PROgressions tab in the Quick Links section near the top of the home page.

Application Deposit: \$250.00 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit secures your place in the program until the Mid-Term deadline (see below).

Application Deposit Deadline: May 29, 2019 or until program fills.

Mid-Term Payment Deadline: The total of your payments must equal at least \$400 as of June 5 to continue to hold your place in the program, and all payments as of this date will also be NON-REFUNDABLE.

Final Payment Deadline: July 3, 2020. Preferred method for all payments is online via the PayPal invoice you will received from us. If, however, final payment is mailed it must be postmarked and trackable by deadline.

Accommodations: Radisson Hotel Branson, double bed rooms, random assignment of 2 Dancers and Moms per room. Roommate requests considered if pre-arranged with TOP staff by June 19.

Optional Private Room Upgrade: \$350.00 extra. Double bed rooms will be requested, but not guaranteed.

Age Limit: Program is by invitation only and open to dancers ages 12-15.

Transportation: Transportation of each dancer is the sole responsibility of the parent attending the event. Program occasionally includes separating the students into groups at different locations. Grouping changes due to transportation issues are not allowed.

Meals: All meals will be the responsibility of the accompanying parent or guardian. No meals provided.

Activities Schedule: Schedule of classes and activities along with other pertinent information will be emailed to paid and confirmed participants prior to the workshop.

Show Tickets: Program includes tickets for 1 dancer and 1 parent to the Sunday July 26 performance of Kidz Roc at the Clay Cooper Theatre. PROgressions participants will sit with our group only as they are ticketed assigned seating in our designated area. Any others attending with you will need to contact the box office directly to purchase their own tickets for the show.

Participant Supervision: Full, appropriate supervision will be provided for the participants during the course of the workshops. Ultimately, however, each dancer & parent will be expected to assume full responsibility for his or her actions at all times. Rules of conduct will be established and participants will be expected to comply. Breaking of the rules may result in immediate expulsion from the workshop without refund.
