



2022 Program Fact Sheet

Purpose: To provide advanced-level dancers a glimpse into the professional dance world and what it takes to make dance a career. To also provide them training by professionals working in the industry, networking opportunities, and an evaluation of where they stand in their preparation for the transition. Program participants also receive a professional working credit as featured dancers in the annual presentation of Kidz Roc at the Clay Cooper Theatre.

Date: Monday, July 18 to Sunday, July 24

Location: Branson, Missouri

Accommodations: Westgate Branson Woods Resort, double beds, 2 dancers per room, rooms assigned by TOP.

Full Program Fee: \$2,295 total prior to any discounts being applied (\$1,795 AFTER SCHOLARSHIP).

Scholarship: \$500 Scholarship awarded to selected dancers (limit one scholarship discount per dancer).

Online Application: To begin the application process log on to talentonparade.com and click on the Go Pro tab in the Quick Links section near the top of the home page. Complete the registration, transportation & medical forms. Dancer application will not be processed until all three required forms have been received. *Dancer is not accepted into the program until you have received the PayPal invoice from TOP for your dancer. Please be aware that the program quickly fills every year and generally has a waiting list ... do not wait if you are planning to attend.*

Application Deposit: \$250 NON-REFUNDABLE deposit required to enroll.

Payment Deadlines: Transportation, additional hotel night and souvenir t-shirt fees are due upon registration and will be billed as part of your initial deposit amount. 2022 Invoice balance deadlines are as follows: Balance must be under \$1295 by May 1st. Balance must be under \$795 by May 31st, balance must be under \$295 by June 17th.

Final Payment Deadline: July 1st, 2022. Final payment must be received. Method for all payments is online via the PayPal invoice you will receive from us; you may also share your PayPal link for others to "donate" to your dancer's tuition payments. PayPal invoice reminders will be sent out to all accounts with a balance showing due monthly up until June and then on a weekly basis until the July 1st final deadline.

Age Restriction: Program is by invitation only and restricted to advanced dancers ages 13 and older. Due to the rigorous nature of this program, beginner/intermediate dancers are discouraged from applying.

Travel To/From Workshop: Participants are responsible for their travel to and from the program. Airport transfers are available for an additional fee of \$100 each way, and must be pre-arranged with TOP staff at registration time. Branson airport has a new airline so be sure and check them out also, otherwise SGF- Springfield will be the airport you would use! Flights must arrive between 1000am-100pm. Dancers driving themselves must turn in their keys at registration and will not have access to their vehicle until the program concludes.

Program Transportation: All necessary transportation during the program will be provided and supervised by TOP.

Extended Stays: An additional fee of \$175 will be charged to any dancer who requires hotel accommodations after the program is dismissed on the evening of Sunday, July 24, 2022. Must be arranged for and paid at registration time.

Meals: Most meals during the program will be provided. A complete list of activities including paid and unpaid meals will be emailed to participants along with any other pertinent information prior to the workshop.

Show Costumes: Performance Shirts will be provided by TOP. An additional list of requested costuming items from the choreographers will be emailed based on the show/act themes. Participants are required to bring these items from their own "street" personal wardrobes.

Participant Supervision: Full, appropriate supervision will be provided for the participants during the course of the program. Ultimately, however, each participant will be expected to assume full responsibility for his or her own actions at all times. Rules of conduct will be established and participants, and parents, will be expected to comply. Breaking of the rules, especially drinking of alcohol or the use of illicit drugs may result in the immediate expulsion from the program without a refund. All student workshops, rehearsals, meals, etc. will be closed to parent/teacher observation. Limiting the parent/teacher contact reinforces the professional nature of this program and allows the participants to remain completely focused. We do however encourage parents/teachers/family/friends to attend one or more of the final professional show performances of Kidz Roc at the end of the week which features the Go Pro Dancers.
